GROUND IMPROVEMENTS

The following are the priority items for ground improvements:

Little Athletics:

Cover for jump pits.

Kennel Club:

Netball:

Boggy area to be drained so that it can be used for parking.

Levelling of car park and filling of potholes. Additional storeroom.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Nicole Hanger: Viola grants are closed.

Nyra Moroz: The canteen shutter is still hard to close. The exhaust fumes from the cricket roller is upsetting some members of WABKC.
