Set out below is Section 10A(2) of the Local Government Act 1993 in relation to matters which can be dealt with in the closed part of a meeting.

On 12 February 2016, JT Consulting Services Pty Ltd filed a Class 1 Application in the NSW Land and Environment Court (LEC. NO 10106 of 2016) against the Notice of Determination dated 17 August 2015 refusing Development Application No. D525-05 for development described as Alterations and Additions to existing commercial building, to create eight (8) ground level shops, nine (9) units of shop-top housing dwellings over new shops and landscaped area at the southern end of the site and a draft Voluntary Planning Agreement at Lot 1 in DP 1005423, No 55-57 Menangle Street, Picton.

Pursuant to section 10A (4) of the Local Government Act 1993 the public are invited to make representations to the Council meeting before any part of the meeting is closed, as to whether that part of the meeting should be closed.

## RECOMMENDATION

- That Council move into Closed Session to consider closed report PE9 NSW Land & Environment Court Proceedings – Commercial Development at 55-57 Menangle Street, Picton.
- 2. That pursuant to Section 10A(1) of the *Local Government Act 1993*, the media and public be excluded from the meeting on the basis that the business to be considered is classified confidential under the provisions of Section 10A(2)(g).
- 3. That the correspondence and reports relevant to the subject business be withheld from access to the media and public as required by Section 11(2) of the *Local Government Act 1993*.
