- 1. That Council considers the confidential report(s) listed below in a meeting closed to the public in accordance with Section 10 A(2) of the Local Government Act 1993:
 - 8.1 Confidential Personnel Matter

This matter is considered to be confidential under Section 10A(2)(a) of the Local Government Act, and the Council is satisfied that discussion of this matter in an open meeting would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest as it deals with personnel matters concerning particular individuals (other than councillors)

- 2. That Mr Malone be appointed to this position until the commencement of a new Chief Executive Officer, given that the recruitment process for a new Chief Executive Officer has commenced and noting the importance of providing organizational stability and continuity of leadership during this transition period between Chief Executive Officers.

- 3. That Council notes the effort and integrity of Mr Malone thus far in leading the organization during the period he has been Acting Chief Executive Officer, and the support he has been provided by members of the Executive Leadership Team.
- 4. That Council thank all staff for their ongoing dedication and for maintaining a focus on delivering positive outcomes for the Wollondilly community during the transition period between Chief Executive Officers.
- 5. That this resolution supersede Resolution 69/2019 in the Ordinary Meeting of Council held on 18 March 2019 to the extent there are any inconsistencies.
