Week 1 Winter Wonderland

- **Monday activities:** Let's learn how to finger knit and see what we can make. Build a giant Ginger Bread House to play in and make giant lolly pops and candy canes to decorate. Make beaded star jewels with straws, wire, sticks, ribbons and beads.
- Tuesday activities: Cooking with Rosie: We are going to cook Mackenzie's Marble Chocolate Mouse. Today we are going to make our own snow to play with. Make a large Pop Stick Star.
- **Wednesday activities:** We will be making a scarf using polar fleece and decorating it with beads and buttons. Weaving Christmas ornaments with a variety of threads. Monster shoes made with tissue boxes, paint, foam and wiggly eyes.
- **Thursday activities:** Create our own Winter Wonderland using a large wooden board and a variety of materials; let your imagination run wild. Make an origami paper petal star. Make paperback Christmas tree using old books. Make a reindeer necklace using a cork, pipe cleaner and pom pom.
- Friday activities: Cooking with Cheryl: Bacon and Cheese Muffins. Today we are going to decorate a pastry brush to look like Santa; we will be using wire, wooden bead, paint, pom poms, fluffy wool and Christmas decorations. We are going to make a winter snow globe using jars and a variety of materials.

Week 2

- Monday activities: Excursion: We are off to Nepean Dam for a BBQ and games.
 <u>CHILDREN WILL NEED TO BE AT THE COTTAGE BY 8:00AM</u>.
 Cooking with Cheryl: Make some yummy Carrot and Orange Cupcakes. In the afternoon you will be doing crayon transfer art.
- **Tuesday activities:** Make a glove toy using gloves, buttons, ribbon and wadding. Weaving loom make a small placemat using a variety of wool in different colours. We will be doing some stone art using stones and different coloured permanent markers.
- **Wednesday activities:** Make a tepee using long sticks, yarn and material. Make a wine cork pendant using paint, fine tip pens and stamps. Plaster casting using Plaster of Paris and a variety of coloured rocks and shells.
- Thursday activities: Cooking with Rosie: Today we will be making Grace's Choc-Mint Mountain Cake. Tie Dye your own T-shirt (please provide your child with a white T- shirt), this activity was requested by Riley. Make your own yarn doll family using different coloured wool and materials.
- **Friday activities**: Let's make a string art wall hanging using string, dowel and dye. Building an Ice City with different shapes and coloured ice. Zentangle drawing, tangle your name.
