Health and Safety:-

The lumps/ bubbled surface at netball note court 3 and 10 is getting larger and needs to be repaired, it has been reported as a CRM. We need to check on when it was first reported for warranty purposes.

No Smoking/ Vaping sign has been proposed we need to see what council are going to do and then we can add to it with some additional signs, we all agree pending what we hear back from council that sports ground to pay for it.

Safety of the staircase fire exit the kids or young people can enter the side of the screen and the stair case an additional partition is required

Bolts sticking up in garbage room

There is no Signage on outside of lift for not using in case of fire. We thought this would be a requirement

We need parking signage on the round about

General Business:-

Nyra has spoken to Peter Myers re 25 years of minutes and we will store them once we get the building.

Motion: Tahmoor sports ground purchase the PA system and hooter system from Netball who owned the original one.

Vote Unanimous.

Price to be negotiated with netball and then we can raise it and the next meeting to confirm the price is suitable

Craig to organise a first aid bed

Approval of committee to spend up to \$1000 on 6 x 80 ltr bins red lid and 6 x 80 ltr bins yellow lid invoice received for under \$700 and will be purchased in immediate future

Tv and audio for function room discussed not ready yet to decide

Craig will get a quote on a Lectern.

BBQ discussed we agree to purchase but want to wait for the new model

Storage.

Discussed the need for sports ground to have storage at the new building for common use items, proposal to swap the sports ground storage shed in the old storage area with one of the new ones. no resolution to date.

On hold: We will invite the other Wollondilly 355 committees to our next meeting if it is going to be held in the new building or postponed if not until the following meeting.

Locks on cupboards for the user groups needs to be sorted We are willing to buy 20 ish sets of crockery and cutlery for bookings, meetings and guests. Maximum budget is \$500 Discussed setting a cupboard aside in the function room for function items. Black table clothes for all 15 tables to be purchased.

Agreed unanimously

Approved maximum budget of \$500

BBQ purchase. We have been advised that the trays were not included and they are an extra \$300.

Vote unanimous to purchase trays as well.

Public Garbage bins for Little a's / netball area as dog dropping bag and public garbage being left around (CRM 53980)

Consider safety barrier for void area (CRM 53988)

Retainers for the doors (CRM 54000)

Approval to install Video cameras

For us to review night time lighting around building

Male public toilet signs to be moved to the door not on the wall as no one is seeing it

Defibrillator to be transferred to first aid room and foyer.

A cupboard in the first aid room for the ground hirers and user groups to be set aside to place first aid kit

Approval for purchase of a first aid kit for first aid room. Damian to look into it and advise will seek a budget when we know more.

A cupboard in first aid room locked for user groups only.

Shopping list

Basic Tool kit budget approved of \$100 and will be stored in common cupboard in first aid room.

Key storage box for inside the cleaners room for all fobs to be issued and key register in it.

Budget \$300 approved

Key lock box to be purchased for casual hirers to be able to collect and drop off their key fobs

Budget \$100 to buy one Damian will look into it

Clocks for the walls was voted against.

Council have insisted that we have a mobile phone for customers to be able to. Approval granted for Craig to find and purchase a mobile phone.

Door mats for main entry

Not approved at this stage need to look into it further.

We need cleaning items for people that hire the grounds and they need access to it.

We think the first aid room cupboard. Which will be marked and left unlocked
