Sustainability Policy

- DRAFT report finalised and going to Council in March 2023
- Caring for Country is a high priority, the policy acknowledges the Dharawal and Gundungurra peoples and regions
- Ibrahim spoke about the next stages once the Policy is adopted and the need to workshop what 'Caring for Country' needs to encompass in the upcoming Sustainability Strategy which will identify clear actions. Ibrahim stated that he would like to hear from the Indigenous community of how best to start the process and work through various items such as engagement, inclusion in Council's decision making, better development practices, how to manage significant sites and other matters of importance.
- Ibrahim sought permission to hold a Cleaning Up Australia event at Potholes carpark which was supported by the members

Ibrahim Muharrem, Environmental Assessment Planner Action - Sustainable Growth will provide clarification to the group. We will be providing clarification around whether the proposal intends to provide direct access to the gorge and how it relates to nearby crown
