**1.1 PICTON PUBLIC SCHOOL - PROPOSED 2 MINUTE TIME RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE (R5-12) INFRONT OF THE SCHOOL ON ARGYLE ST**

**RECOMMENDATION**

**That Council**

- 1. Approve 12m of 2 minutes time restricted parking zone (R5-12) within the southern end of the existing parking zone in front of Picton Public School on Argyle St.**

**1.2 ARGYLE ST / MARGARET ST / CLIFFE ST, PICTON TRAFFIC LIGHT INTERSECTION - REVIEW OF EXISTING TRAFFIC ZONES ON EASTERN SIDE OF ARGYLE ST FOR SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC**

**RECOMMENDATION**

**That the Local Traffic Committee:**

- 1. To review existing traffic zones on eastern side of Argyle St for southbound traffic with the view of improving traffic flow noting its likely to have a negative impact on on-street parking**

#### 1.4 PRODUCTION AVE, WARRAGAMBA APPROACHING WARRADALE RD INTERSECTION - REQUEST FOR TRANSVERSE ROAD MARKINGS (SPEED AWARENESS BARS)

##### RECOMMENDATION

That the Local Traffic Committee:

1. Approves the implementation of transverse road markings (speed awareness bars – 300mm wide) on Production Ave, Warragamba approaching Warradale Rd intersection as shown on the attachment of this report.

### Picton High School Opening

- Picton High school is scheduled to re-open at the beginning of Term 2. Chris Moule has been advised that the bus zone will be moved back to the main entry of the school along Argyle St. Once a trial period takes place Chris will advise Council that the temporary bus zone along Wonga Rd will be made available for parking use.
- Chris has recently noticed that the new pedestrian refuge being implemented along Argyle St will remove a current bus zone. He advised that we will also trail this and if there are any issues he will report it to Council staff.
