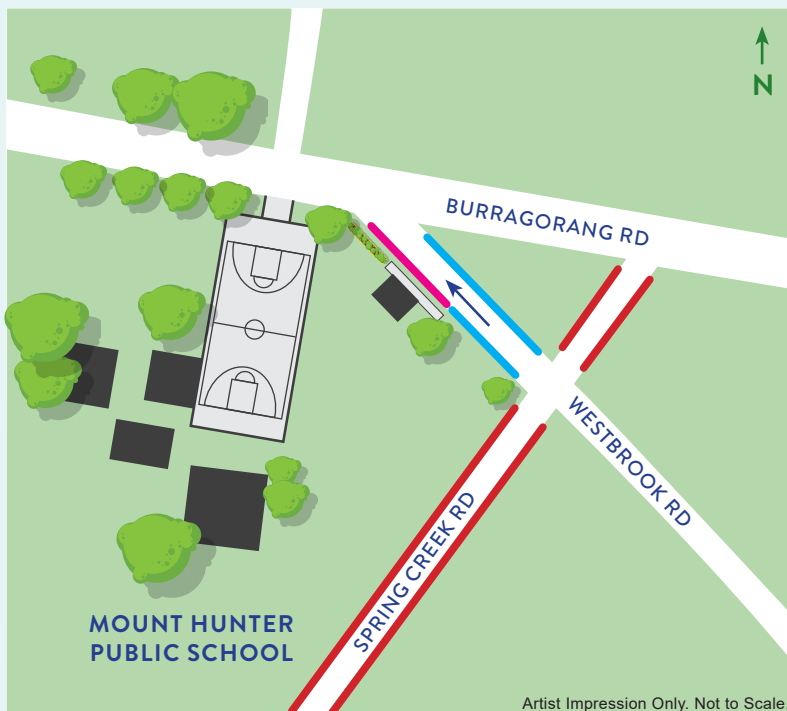


### PICK UP | DROP OFF | STAY SAFE

#### New Pick Up & Drop Off Zones - Help ensure everyone's safety

The parking zones around Mount Hunter Public School are changing to safely accommodate the morning drop off and afternoon pick up.

#### WHERE



#### KEY

- **No Stopping**
- **10 Minute Parking Zone**  
Time restricted (8:00-9:30am & 2:30-4:00pm school days)
- **Bus Zone**  
Time restricted (8:00-9:30am & 2:30-4:00pm school days)
- ← **One Way**
- Building/Shelter**
- Concrete/Footpath**

- Westbrook Rd (south side) – 10 minute parking for a length of 20m
- Westbrook Rd (north side) – 10 minute parking for a length of 20m
- Spring Creek Road from Burragorang Road - 'No Stopping' zones on both sides for 140m (south)
- Westbrook Rd (south side) - 'Bus zone' during school hours 8:00-9.30am & 2.30-4:00pm) for a length of 22m

#### WHY

- The dedicated 10 minute parking areas allow parents and caregivers to safely park and leave their vehicles to drop off and pick up children at school times.
- The new arrangements mitigate traffic congestion and promote safety for pedestrians and road users.
- The new arrangements ensure drivers are compliant with the NSW Road Rules.

#### WHEN

Keep an eye out for new signage in December.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **Why can't I park in the school grounds?**

The Department of Education identified in a risk assessment that non-authorized parking within school grounds is no longer permitted.

## **Why can't Council construct a parking bay on Spring Creek Road?**

There is insufficient road width to be able to construct a parking bay without blocking footpath access.

## **Why can't I park on/over the roll kerb?**

Parking on the nature strip/footpath area is prohibited under the NSW Road Rules.

## **Why is there to be 'No Stopping' on both sides of Spring Creek Rd?**

The road is too narrow for on-street parking and obstructs through traffic.

## **Why is the bus zone area reduced?**

The bus operator has advised that it requires one bus length.

## **Can I park in the bus zone?**

Parking is not permissible within a bus zone unless it is a public bus.

## **Can I park on both sides of Westbrook Rd (near the memorial)?**

Yes - parking is permissible according to the traffic sign installed.

## **What does P 10 minute sign mean?**

Parking is permissible up to 10 minutes in duration.

## **Can I park for longer than 10 minutes outside of school times?**

Yes, there are no parking restrictions outside of school drop off and pick up times, as indicated on the signs.

## **Can I park on Westbrook Rd (near the church)?**

Yes, there are no restrictions to parking at this stage.
