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### **OPENING BY THE CHAIRPERSON**

The Chairperson, Cr Landow opened the Community Forum at 6.35 pm. The Chairperson welcomed all those in attendance at the Community Forum. The Chairperson introduced the Mayor, Cr Hannan; Councillors, the General Manager, Directors and to the Community Forum participants.

### **DECLARATION OF INTEREST**
