



- Continuation of rural character outside the two Priority Growth Areas to 2036.





### WILTON NEW TOWN


- 2,800ha developable land.

- Mining constraints need to be resolved before rezoning proceeds on constrained land.





### INFRASTRUCTURE PROVISION


- Special Infrastructure Contribution (SIC) schemes- at no additional cost to government - to coordinate funding and delivery of regional infrastructure.
- A SIC scheme would allow additional contributions from other fragmented owners.
- Individual planning agreements to manage infrastructure risksdefining triggers for delivery before a particular stage can proceed.




