# REPORT

#### BACKGROUND

The Local Traffic Committee is a Technical Committee of Roads and Maritime Services. The Committee operates under the authority conferred to Council by the RMS under the Transport Administration Act 1988.

Council has been delegated certain powers from the RMS, with regard to traffic matters upon its local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the Traffic Committee recommendations.

There are four permanent members of the Traffic Committee, each of whom has a single vote only. The members are representatives of the NSW Police Force, the Roads and Maritime Services, the Local State Member of Parliament (for the location of the issue to be voted upon) and a representative of Council.

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# RECOMMENDATION

That Council resolve to adopt the Recommendations of the Local Traffic Committee Meeting of 7 December 2016 as follows:

# 1. <u>Thirlmere Festival of Steam 2017 – Request for Temporary Road</u> <u>Closures</u>

- That Council grant permission for the use of the following roads in Thirlmere:
  - 1. Oaks Street from the railway crossing to Carlton Road;
  - 2. Westbourne Avenue from South Street. to Oaks Street;
  - 3. Barbour Road from Oaks Street to Close Street; and
  - 4. Mason Street from Barbour Road. to Goodlet Street (proposed to be used for accessibility parking)
  - 5. Station Street between Bell Street and Thirlmere Way between 11.30am to 1.30pm; small section of Goodlet Street; and a small section of Oaks Street between Goodlet Street and Carlton Road; and between Thirlmere Way and railway crossing for 30mins. Only at 1.00pm for the street parade.

# 2. <u>Removal of the Load Limit Restrictions on Fergusson Road and</u> <u>Ruddocks Road, Lakesland</u>

 That Council remove the existing load limit restrictions on Fergusson Road and Ruddocks Road, Lakesland.

# 3. Parking Restrictions on Yallambi Street, Picton

• That endorse the implementation of an edgeline marking on Yallambi Street, Picton.
