Projects Completed/Under Way in the 3rd Quarter

Shire Library Renovation - 75% of electrical, hydraulic and mechanical services and internal fit-out work is complete. In April the internal lift and awning steel structure will be installed.

Bargo Streetscape - Concrete works, kerb & gutter, planter boxes and street furniture installation for the first three stages is complete. The final stage of construction work will resume in early April.

Garbutt PI, Oakdale - During January the road was milled using a profiler, spray sealed to waterproof the pavement and then resurfaced with asphaltic concrete.

Bollard PI, Picton - To minimise disruption to businesses, reconstruction of the culdesac was carried out over two nights in late January.

Lisa Rd, Wilton - Heavy patching works were carried out in December and road reconstruction was completed in February.

Spring Creek Rd - Following drainage works and heavy patching in December, road reconstruction of a 300 metre section was carried out in March.

Silverdale Rd, Big Hill Rd to Garlicks Range Rd - Preparation for road reconstruction was in full swing in March, with works scheduled to begin at Orangeville in early April.

Remembrance Dwy, Cawdor - Night works were carried out during March due to the very high traffic volume in the area, involving extensive asphaltic concreting. A spray seal for this stretch of road is scheduled for later in 2016.

Whipbird Rd, Pheasants Nest - Maintenance works and construction of a turning bay was carried out in March.

Bargo Sportsfield Maintenance Shed Upgrade – Minor upgrade works on five buildings (AFL Change Room, small Amenities Room, Tennis Club House, Scout Hall and Trotting Tower) at Bargo Sportsground are complete.

Remembrance Dwy, Myrtle Creek Shared Footpath - Design is now complete and the existing spray seal pathway will be reconstructed using concrete during April, with 50% of funding provided by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

Regreme Rd, Picton - Roundabout design is complete and relocation of services is under way with construction scheduled to begin in April.

Bargo Sportsground Drainage - Drainage work is due to commence in early April. The existing irrigation system will be capped off where needed, followed by installation of new irrigation (at a lower depth) with risers for the sprinkler heads and placement of the sprinklers.

Wilton Sportsground – Council is currently working with a consultant to prepare a draft Wilton Recreation Reserve Master Plan which will be placed on public exhibition over the coming months. Construction is expected to start in the new Financial Year.

Picton Sportsground Bridge - The bridge is currently out to tender with a report expected to go to the May Council Meeting. Construction will follow later in the year.
