The Local Traffic Committee is a Technical Committee of Roads and Maritime Services (RMS). The Committee operates under the authority conferred to Council by the RMS under the Transport Administration Act 1988.

Council has been delegated certain powers from the RMS, with regard to traffic matters upon its local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the Traffic Committee recommendations.

There are four permanent members of the Traffic Committee, each of whom has a single vote only. The members are representatives of the NSW Police Force, the RMS, the Local State Member of Parliament (for the location of the issue to be voted upon) and a representative of Council.

## 1.1 WONGA ROAD, PICTON – ROAD EXTENSION AND PROPOSE TRAFFIC ZONES ADJACENT TO TEMPORARY PICTON HIGH SCHOOL COMPOUND UPDATE

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to request to extend and implement new traffic zones on Wonga Road, Picton for access in/out of Picton High temporary school compound revisit.

#### **REPORT**

Council has received an updated design plan of the proposed road extension with a new roundabout and new traffic zones on section of Wonga Road adjacent to the new temporary Picton High School compound. In addition, new time restricted Bus Zone along the western side of Wonga Rd opposite Picton Buslines added in response to LTC concerns of lack of holding parking space for bus services.

The contractor for the project is in continuing consultation with Council; State and RMS representatives to finalise the associated road related matters such as additional traffic zones (School Zone; parking zones for students); traffic management on Wonga Rd and at the junction with Argyle St.

No Stopping Zones will be implemented on the southern side of Wonga Rd along the boundary fence between the gate at the rear entrance to the school and the church. This will encourage pedestrians to use the northern side of Wonga Rd where the buses are waiting.

#### Consultation

This issue has not been raised and discussed in a Community Forum. Ongoing consultation among stake holders.

#### **Financial Implications**

This matter has no financial impact on Council's adopted budget or forward estimates.



#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to request the endorsement of proposed delineation upgrade on Marsh Road, Silverdale in association with new "Simba Developments" sub-division at 41 Marsh Road, Silverdale.

#### **REPORT**

Council has approved the DA for 426 lots of residential subdivision "Simba Developments" at 41 Marsh Road, Silverdale. The application is an outcome of the decision of the Regional Planning Panel who on 17 September determined DD010.2015.00000935.001.

In the previous LTC meeting, the line marking plan was considered but require further review to conform to standard layout. An amended line marking plan has been received for endorsement.

#### Consultation

This DA has been processed via public submissions and public meetings held at Warragamba Community Hall.

Roads and Maritime Services has no objection to the development application.

## DA 010.2015.00000935.001 – MIRRAGAN ESTATE MARSH ROAD - PROPOSED SIGNPOSTING AND LINEMARKING PLANS

Please find attached the linemarking and signage plans associated with the proposed upgrade of Marsh Road, Silverdale. This design has been formulated to satisfy condition 17 of the Integrated Development Consent 010.2015.00000935.001.

The intersection of Road 1 with Marsh Road has been designed as a give-way controlled intersection in accordance with Austroads "Guide to Traffic Management Part 10 – Traffic Control and Communication Devices" and AS 1742.2 "Traffic control devices for general use".

The intersection of Road 2 and Marsh Road has been designed in accordance with the conditions of consent, specifically:

"Provision of a basic left turn treatment (BAL) together with a basic right turn treatment (BAR) for the intersection of road 2 with Marsh Road."

The plan, developed also in accordance with the standards outlined in Austroads "Guide to Road Design Part 4A - Unsignalised and Signalised Intersections" & "Guide to Traffic Management Part 10 - Traffic Control and Communication Devices", and AS 1742.2 "Traffic control devices for general use", represents the most compact solution to this requirement. It allows for vehicles travelling in either direction on Marsh Road to safely pass other vehicles waiting to turn into either Road 02 or Coveny St. This is achieved by the provision of short passing lanes through the intersection, which are demarcated by appropriate linemarking. Turning arrows are provided as necessary to further clarify the operation of the intersection.

The use of painted edge lines rather than kerbs and islands minimises the impact on existing and future lots as it will not impede current and future residents' access to their driveways.

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The intersection of Marsh Road and Warradale Road has been designed as a stop sign controlled intersection in accordance with Austroads "Guide to Traffic Management Part 10 – Traffic Control and Communication Devices" and AS 1742.2 "Traffic control devices for general use".

Finally, the existing signage on Marsh Road as it approaches Warradale Road, specifically a W1-3(R) and a W2-3, will be relocated to suit the newly upgraded & widened road.

It is therefore our opinion that the attached plans represent an effective and safe solution to the issue of traffic movement through Marsh Road.


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
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## 1.3 GREENBRIDGE DRIVE, WILTON – PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF 'NO U TURN' (R2-5A) ON EXISTING CONCRETE MEDIAN

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to request the installation of a "No U Turn" (R52-5A) sign on median strip of Greenbridge Drive, for east bound traffic on approach to junction with White Street.

#### **REPORT**

During traffic monitoring, Council observed motorists making U Turns on Greenbridge Drive in front of Wilton Public School. This is dangerous to pedestrians as it is close to the pedestrian refuge and hazardous to motorists exiting out of White Street, turning right.

#### Consultation

The issue has not been raised and discussed in the community forum.

Funding has been allocated and is available under vote 4402-5210-3627.

#### 2.1 SPARTAN RACE 2019

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to provide the committee with information in relation to Spartan Race 2019.

#### **RFPORT**

Council has received a notification as consent condition of an extended DA approval for Special Event (Obstacle Course Event – "Spartan Race") to be held on 4 May 2019 at a Recreation Facility off Picton Rd (MR 612). This event obtained a rolling Council approval up to 2019.

The event will attract high traffic volumes over the period with anticipated number of participants (4500 participants + 2000 spectators) and has the potential to create adverse road safety and traffic impact on Picton Rd.

The event is classified as "Class 1 special event" under the Guide to Traffic and Transport Management for Special Events".


The application has prepared a Traffic & Transport Management Plan, Risk Assessment Report and Event Management Plan & Statement of Environmental Effect as part of the DA consent condition.

As the event is classified as "Class 1 special event" under the "Guide to Traffic and Transport Management for Special Events" and the traffic impact is on classified road (Picton Rd – MR612), it is the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) responsibility to decide what conditions to impose as well as Police concurrence.


