EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The Local Traffic Committee agenda was issued electronically on 9 February 2017 to consider a number of reports for traffic management in the Wollondilly Local Government Area and to submit the Recommendations for Council's consideration at the Local Traffic Committee held 15 February 2017. The agenda papers were distributed to all Councillors.
- It is recommended that Council resolve to adopt the Recommendations of the Local Traffic Committee meeting of 15 February 2017.

REPORT

BACKGROUND

The Local Traffic Committee is a Technical Committee of Roads and Maritime Services. The Committee operates under the authority conferred to Council by the RMS under the Transport Administration Act 1988.

Council has been delegated certain powers from the RMS, with regard to traffic matters upon its local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the Traffic Committee recommendations.

There are four permanent members of the Traffic Committee, each of whom has a single vote only. The members are representatives of the NSW Police Force, the Roads and Maritime Services, the Local State Member of Parliament (for the location of the issue to be voted upon) and a representative of Council.

RECOMMENDATION

That Council resolve to adopt the Recommendations of the Local Traffic Committee Meeting of 15 February 2017 as follows:

1. Proposed line marking modification on Margaret St, Picton approaching the new traffic lights
