- 6. Artworks along with entry forms must be submitted to the Wollondilly Shire Council by 5pm on Friday 31st August.
- 7. Any artworks submitted after Friday 31st August 2018 will not be accepted.
- 8. Any transport or postage costs associated with the delivery or submission of artworks are at Artist's own expense.
- 9. Wollondilly Shire Council is not liable for any damage, loss or theft of any artwork entered in the "Local Reflections of Warragamba" Art Competition.
- 10. Entrants of the "Local Reflections of Warragamba" Art Competition give permission for Wollondilly Shire Council to use their artworks for advertising, publications and promotional purposes.
- 11. If your artwork is chosen as a winner of the "Local Reflections of Warragamba", Wollondilly Shire Council then become the owner of the artworks and have the rights to use the artworks as they wish, Wollondilly Shire Council will endeavor to consult with Artists prior to use.
