#### 1 REPORTS

#### 1.1 PROPOSED TRANSFORMATION OF WALTON LANE INTO ONE WAY LANEWAY, EAST BOUND, FROM WALTON STREET TO ARGYLE STREET.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Council endorse the proposed Walton Lane Transformation into one way laneway, formalisation of parallel on street parking (south side) and associated traffic signs.

#### Comments:

Jayd Marsh commented installation of pavement arrows in the direction of travel could be considered to reinforce the direction of travel in the laneway.

No entry sign to be monitored after one way lane is in operation, additional no right turn and no left turn signage on Argyle St to be considered if no entry sign is deemed not effective.

#### 1.2 BARGO PUBLIC SCHOOL – "BARGO PUBLIC SCHOOL FETE 2019" – REQUEST FOR ROAD CLOSURE ON SECTION OF GREAT SOUTHERN RD BETWEEN BARGO RD AND AVON DAM RD ON SATURDAY 26TH OCTOBER 2019

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Council approve the road closure of Great Southern Road, Bargo from railway overbridge to the south of the school and the intersection of Great Southern Road and Bargo Road between the hours of 7.30am and 4.00pm on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019 for the staging of "Bargo Public School Fete 2019" subject to the requirements of a "Road Event – Road Closure" permit.

#### Comments:

Akash explained the vacant block adjacent to Bargo Hotel will no longer be used, therefore there is no pedestrian movement from the vacant block to the school.

VMB will no longer be used on Remembrance Driveway as advised from Bargo Public School since issuing this report.

An updated TCP was provided to the committee with Hostile Vehicle Mitigations (HVM) added.

Mick commented Bargo Public School will need to complete a Notice of Intention to hold a Public

Assembly form to receive concurrence from NSW Department of Police.

Jayd Marsh questioned if there was sufficient parking arrangements for attendees and spectators.

Norma clarified that spectators will have to use on street parking.
