#### 1. <u>Wollondilly Koala Conservation Project</u>

Wollondilly Shire Council's 'Koala Conservation Project' has grown over the last two years with recent surveys proving that there is a healthy colony of breeding koalas in the region.

Through funding from the Saving Our Species Program, Council has been working with the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) and wildlife ecologists to survey for and track koalas, gathering important information about where they occur, what they eat, where their habitat and corridors are and whether disease is present in the population.

The Wollondilly Koala Hotline was set up in February 2015 and since then we have had over 60 reports of koalas in Appin, Broughton Pass, Douglas Park, Wilton, Bargo, Thirlmere, Lakesland, Silverdale and Bents Basin.
