That Council in recognition of three brave Wollondilly residents who made the ultimate sacrifice for their country on the battle fields of France in October of 1917, name our most recent sportsground(s) in their honour.

- Private John Stuart Dyce 30th Battalion; 17/10/1917 aged 26
- Private Cecil Charles Crockford of Bargo 2nd Battalion 04/10/1917 aged 22
- Private Clifford John Clarke of Burragorang 30th Battalion 04/10/1917.

Their names are inscribed on the Menin Gate Memorial. The Longstaff painting "Menin Gate at Midnight" captures the poignancy of this time, a copy was purchased by Brigadier-General George Macleay Macarthur Onslow, President of the Wollondilly Shire at the time is currently on loan to the Heritage Society at The Oaks.
