Tahmoor District Cricket Club:

- Water meter ready. Want alternating sprinkler system with electrics and timer system accessed by phone. The bore is empty. Can supply the committee with a watering schedule. They expect it will use less water than in previous years. Approval given in principle.
- **Motion:** "The committee approves the extension to the field 3 cricket nets and the extension of length and width of field 3 cricket pitch. Any costs involved in moving the soccer goal post sleeves will be covered by TDCC"

• NSW Netball recognise Wollondilly as a high need for improvement

The following are the priority items for ground improvements carried over:

Little Athletics: Cover for jump pits.

<u>Kennel Club</u>: Area around canteen and toilets needs to be cleaned up, levelled and surfaced (bitumen or turf, as appropriate).Seating around field.

<u>Netball</u>: Boggy area to be drained so that it can be used for parking. Additional storeroom. Irrigation of grass courts.

<u>Soccer</u> Barbeque area. Portable grandstand / raised seating. Possible joint venture. <u>Cricket</u>: Movable sight screens. Permanent shaded seating. Move bottom cricket net. More seating.

GENERAL BUSINESS

- Craig Bethune has been nominated as a Cricket delegate. He will contact council to organise training.
- Plumber has been out twice for septic tank at the front of netball canteen. Need to check next weekend. Plumber can come out on Sundays.

• Revisited Dec double booking – both user groups put their points forward. Bob suggested all user groups to write to Jai Rowell.

Craig and Damien (TDCC) and Nyra and Carol (WABKC) left the room. David and Kaylene had to leave due to prior engagement.

Motion: "For the 8th December 2018, TDCC will five full information to Camden Cricket Association that the turf wicket (field 1, Nathan Teddy Graham Oval) will not be available. Field 2 will be available until 11:30am and Field 3 (athletics) may be used until 5:30pm. WABKC will contact Dogs NSW and choose a new date, between April and August, for 2019 onwards."
