

## **Mayoral Fishing Competition Terms & Conditions**

- 1. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 2. All children must remain under constant adult supervision throughout the competition.
- 3. All registrations must be signed by the supervising adult before the child can begin competing.
- 4. All entrants must be under 15 years of age.
- 5. Participation is on a booking system basis and Council reserves the right to limit the number of entrants at any time.
- 6. Fishing is restricted to the Silt Pond within Picton Botanic Gardens only.
- 7. No fish are to be caught prior to 8:30am and after 11:30am on Thursday 26 January 2023
- 8. Entrants are encouraged to be present at the prize drawing in order to claim the prize.
- 9. If you fail to register you will not be eligible to win a prize.
- 10. Participants are encouraged to return all non-European Carp to the Silt Pond.
- 11. Participants agree to have their names disclosed for judging and publicity purposes.
- 12. Participants agree to photographs being taken for judging and publicity purposes.
- 13. Registration will only be accepted during times as determined by Council.
- 14. Participants can win only one prize during the competition.
- 15. It is the responsibility of entrants to ensure that all fish caught are reported as soon as possible to the organisers.
- 16. Participants and Adult Supervisors acknowledge that fishing is an activity which contains elements of risk and danger.
- 17. Participants and Adult Supervisors accept full responsibility for their own safety and that of the competing children and the risks and consequences of participating in any organised event.
- 18. All fish must be caught on rod, reel or hand line with only one hook attached to the line.
- 19. Only one fishing line per child can be in the water at one time.
- 20. Fishing will be conducted in 30 minute time periods on a rotation basis of 35 children. This is to ensure that all children have a chance to fish without over crowding the pond.
- 21. Breach of any of these rules may lead to participants being disqualified from the competition at Councils discretion.
- 22. Prizes will be awarded for: Biggest Fish (weight), Longest Fish (length), Most Fish Caught and Shortest Fish (length)
